4. Program Benefits

- o. Program contents
 - a. Career Development Center in HUFs offers career counseling, pre-training and post-education to ensure that applicants can get a job position based on individual interests
 - b. Professor in the major will be designated as a mentor to help students adapt to the region
- o. Financial support
 - a. Study Abroad : KRW 3,500,000
 - b. Internship Training : KRW 6,500,000
 - * It is responsibility of the individual to tuition, housing, and other monthly expenses
- o. Academic Credit Recognition : HUFs students will transfer academic credits obtained during the program.

5. Application Qualifications

- o Applicants should be in good health, both mentally and physically, to stay in the region for a long period of time.
- o Applicants must be able to support himself/herself financially for living expenses in the region for the duration of HUFs Honors program.
- o Applicants should complete at least 2-year of coursework at HUFs
- o Applicants must be recommended directly by the Dean of the major department.
